

## Appendix 4. - Rewards in School 2007.

### Teams.

- The school will be organised into three teams with one class from each year group in each team.
- This will facilitate all age team assemblies and opportunities for classes to work together on a regular basis so that children develop real friendships outside their own year group.
- Team points are awarded for achievement outside the classroom.
- Children may be awarded a 'team point' signified by a recyclable laminated star(G and Ts) token by any member of staff in school for behaviour which demonstrates the principles of the SEAL project.
- Team points will be displayed on the class notice board/ main notice board (to be decided).
- There will be winning classes each week for upper and lower school who will be awarded a cup and this will be prominently displayed with a class photograph.
- All team points will be totalled at the end of the half-term to decide the winning team and a cup will be presented at assembly.
- Julia will allocate classes to teams in order to try to achieve a balance.
- Since we remix some classes at the end of each year children may not stay in the same team right through the school.

### Merits.

- Stars/stickers will be awarded in class for achievement in learning – this can be academic or social/emotional. Any number can be awarded at a time at the teacher's discretion right up to 5 equalling a full merit.
- Stars/stickers will build towards a merit represented by an address label printed with the caption 'Winton Primary School Merit'. Merits build towards Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum awards.
- Suggested tariff:
  - 5 points = 1 merit
  - 20 merits = Bronze certificate
  - 40 merits = Silver certificate
  - 60 merits = Gold certificate
  - 100 merits = Platinum certificate
- Certificates will be awarded in Year assemblies.

Class star of the week.

One child from each class in the lower school (years R – 3) will be nominated to receive a certificate as ‘star of the week at the Friday celebration assembly. Teachers will try to ensure that every child achieves this award once during the year.
